

2017 PINOT GRIGIO

The southern Margaret River fruit was handpicked from our Estate Vineyard and blended with carefully selected parcels from our Mount Barker and Frankland River sites. It has created a delightful wine with all sites benefitting from cool night temperatures at harvest. The Margaret River fruit contributes the lifted melon nuances, the Frankland River the richer rounder pallet and the Mount Barker fruit lends a fine acid structure to create a balanced wine of outstanding quality.
